We have an annual open Quilt Show/Strawberry Fest featuring the quilts of local quilting artisans in the Cultural Arts Building and Ebenezer Church.

Quilters who participate receive free admission both days. They can meet and share with other quilters the important role quilting has played in the lives of many families. Local quilters will be able to share information about their Quilt Guild meetings, educational opportunities, and the many community services they engage in.

There will be space for approximately 50 quilts on display, and quilts will be organized for display on Friday afternoon prior to the event. Quilts will be accepted on a first-come basis, with older, historical quilts with their stories given priority.
